City of Moncton Field User Guide

Updated

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1. INTRODUCTION AND BOOKING PROCESS

The intent of this document is to assist recreational or sporting groups with general information and an overview of the booking process when requesting the use of any field booked through the City of Moncton. In addition to fields that are owned and operated by the City of Moncton, this guide and booking process applies to other fields, such as those included in reciprocal agreements with the City and community partners (e.g.: Anglophone East School District for school fields during the summer and l'Université de Moncton for Stade Croix Blue Medavie Stadium).

All casual booking inquiries (one-time or temporary use) can be requested by completing the online booking request form, available on the City of Moncton's **website here.** Seasonal bookings inquiries can be directed to the City's booking agent, Christine Lawson, at **lawson@superiorpropanecentre.com** or by phone at **506-384-4423 (ext. 221)** to receive the online form for seasonal bookings.

The deadline to submit the application for seasonal bookings is March 31 of each year.

Please note that all requests received after the deadline of March 31, will be held for review until all applications submitted by the deadline have been accommodated.

3. FIELD ALLOCATION/DISTRIBUTION PROCESS

4. CONTACT INFORMATION

All field inquiries and/or service requests should be directed to the City of Moncton booking agent, Christine Lawson, by email at lawson@superiorpropanecentre.com or by phone at 506-382-4423 (ext. 221).

No group should contact field staff individually or make any special request to staff on-site. All special requests (related to bookings, field amenities, or otherwise) must be made through the **City's booking agent no later than one week** before the booking date.

5. SPORTS FIELD PERMITS

All groups **must obtain a Sports Field Permit** to use the fields. Upon confirmation of your bookings, this permit will be issued to you through the booking agent.

It will also be the responsibility of the organization to provide full league schedules for each of the fields that they have received a permit for, no later than June 15 (unless alternative arrangements have been made with the booking agent) to ensure that appropriate maintenance and lines are in place for your booking. If no schedules are provided, the City may discontinue maintenance of the fields.

Should any user groups encounter individuals and/or groups using the fields without a booking permit, please note the date and time of the occurrence to inform our booking agent. The City of Moncton will follow-up on these reports as needed.

6. EMERGENCY CONTACT

In case of an emergency with the field and/or booked amenities such as washrooms out-of-service, inoperable lights, or in the in the case of a last-minute schedule change due to weather, groups can call the City of Moncton's 24/7 Public Works Dispatch line at **506-859-2643** and ask for the Foreman on duty for fields.

7. CANCELLATION PROCEDURES

WEATHER OR MAINTENANCE

The City of Moncton reserves the right to cancel field bookings due to inclement weather or for required repairs and maintenance to fields.

When cancellations occur due to weather, the City of Moncton will update the Sports Field Conditions webpage no later than 3 p.m.: https://www.moncton.ca/things-do/sports

USER CANCELLATIONS

Due to the considerable interest in field bookings and to provide available space to other interested groups, it is imperative that all users advise the City of Moncton's booking agent if they do not intend to use any scheduled booking time.

A **notice of five business days** must be provided to the booking agent when cancelling a booking.

If **five days' notice** is not given, no refund will be provided for all groups who are required, pursuant to the City's Field Distribution Policy, to pay for their bookings. For youth groups that are not required to pay an hourly rate, a **"no-show" fee of \$25** will be charged. Groups not paying the cancellation fee, as specified in the policy, will be subject to revocation of their field privileges.

8. WASHROOM ACCESS

Where washrooms are available, the booking agent will provide the booking contact with the necessary information to access the washrooms. For information on which fields have washroom access, please refer to **Section 10** (**Field Information**)



9. STANDARD FIELD LEVEL OF SERVICE AND FIELD CLASSIFICATIONS

Any additional special maintenance request not outlined under the Levels of Service below must be submitted at least one week in advance of the request.

11. BOOKING GUIDELINES

SEASONAL CONTRACTS

A seasonal contract is defined as an 18 week or longer contract for a two-hour booking per week. To book a seasonal contract, you must book at least 18 weeks. No cancellations will be accepted.

ONE TIME BOOKING

A casual booking - is based on availability of fields after the seasonal bookings have been completed.

TOURNAMENT AVAILABILITY

Tournaments are not allowed on City fields until the first weekday following the Victoria Day weekend.

NATIONAL OR INTERNATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP TOURNAMENTS

These requests will be determined on a case-by-case basis with agreements specific to each event.

ALCOHOL

No alcohol is permitted on fields. If a group or an association would like permission to sell alcohol, they must request a special events liquor license through Service New Brunswick.



12. BY-LAW - RECREATION AREAS - CITY OF MONCTON

All field users must follow the provisions of the City of Moncton's By-law on Recreation Areas (By-Law #H-302). Highlights of the By-law, as it relates to field users, includes:

- Any user groups caught using a sports field without a contract will be subject to lost future use of the field.
- Any person who fails to comply with any rules or regulations posted at or in a recreation area, after having been given a warning by a person responsible for the supervision of the recreation area to comply with said rules and regulations, may be evicted from such recreation area.
- Any person who wishes to use a recreation area at a specified time shall reserve the use of such recreation area with the General Manager of Community Services, or designate.
- No person shall use a recreation area during the time for which such recreation area has been previously reserved as provided for herein.
