Please be advised that I may delegate some or all my responsibilities associated with the field reviews to another person employed by the undersigned or their firm where it is consistent with prudent professional practice to do so. The functions will however be performed under my supervision in accordance with the performance standards outlined by my Association.

The undersigned shall notify the Planning and Development Department in writing, as soon as practical but no later than 5 working days, if the contract for field review is terminated at any time during construction.
