Paul Joseph Doiron first stepped in the boxing ring when he was 11 years old but his connection to the sport predates his birth. Born into the famous boxing family headed by Jerry Doiron, Paul shares membership in the Canadian Boxing Hall of Fame with his father and three brothers. Paul honed his amateur skills in Ontario and turned pro when he returned to his native Moncton at age 19. In his career, he won 20 of his 25 pro fights. His championship titles include Maritime Light Heavyweight; Eastern Canadian Middleweight and Canadian Amateur Light Middleweight in Ontario. Paul lived by the belief that boxing teaches respect for self and for others.
