Harry SMYTH

Athlete - Speed Skating

Harry Smyth was the first Moncton-born athlete to compete in the Olympic Games, earning a place on the 1932 speed-skating team thanks to many previous triumphs on the ice, including two Canadian championships. In 1928, Harry won every title for which he competed, including provincial, Maritime, Canadian, North American and world championships. That year, he set a new Canadian record for winning the 440-yard sprint in 37.4 seconds. A member of the NB Sports Hall of Fame, Harry competed for 21 years.
