Caleb Dunn's stock car racing career began in 1952 in Saint John, where he won the first Maritime Championship and ended in 1984 at the Riverglade Speedway. In between he won more than 200 races, including 11 consecutive main events. In 1982 he finished seventh in a field of 100 at the World Series of Stock Car Racing at New Symnra Beach Speedway in Florida. He is remembered for the "Cannonball", a Comet which he often raced.
