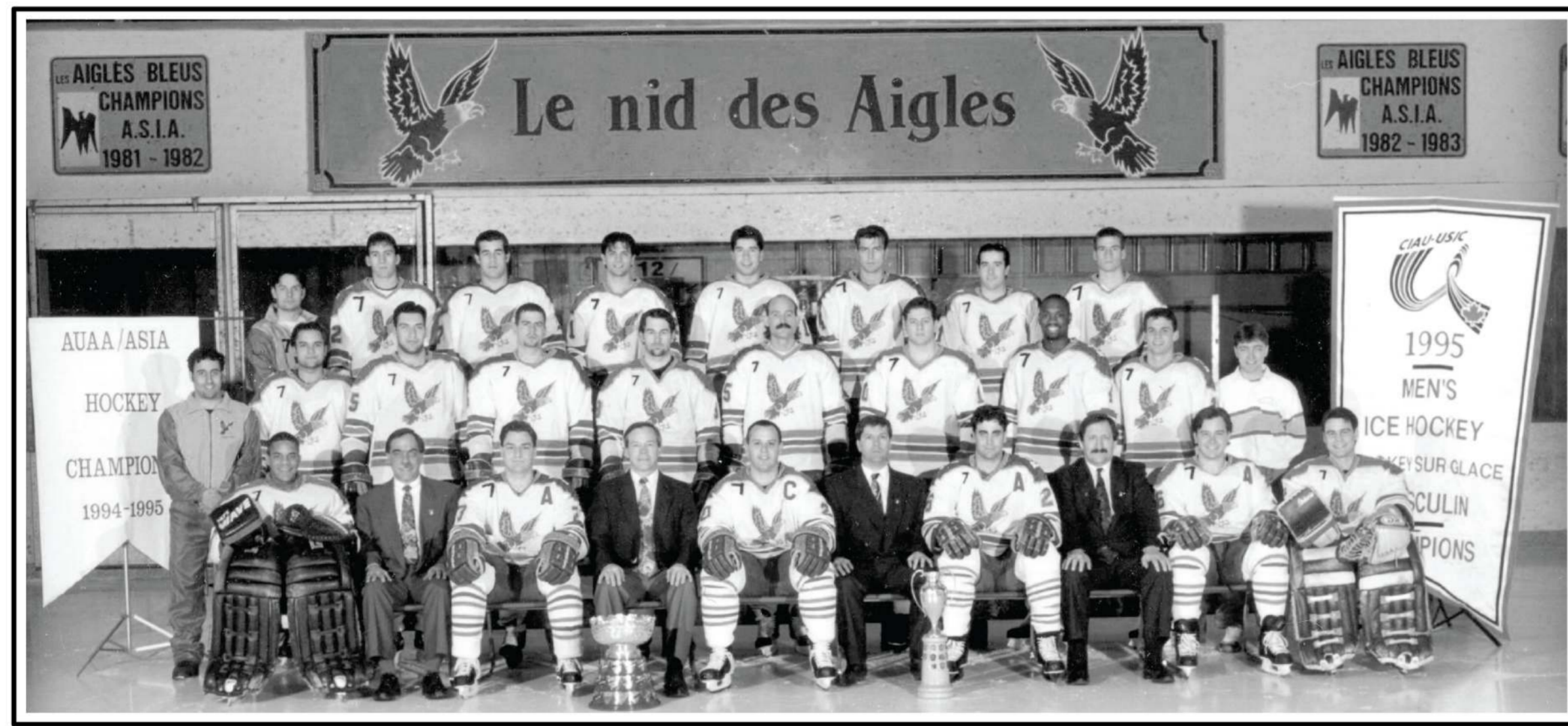


# 2014 INDUCTEE

## Les **AIGLES BLEUS** (1994-1995)

### Team – Hockey

The 1994-1995 season was an exceptional one for the Université de Moncton Aigles Bleus men's hockey team. The team would finish second in the McAdam division at the end of the regular season. In the playoffs, the "Bleu et Or" won six consecutive games on route to capturing their eighth Atlantic Universities Athletics Association (AUAA) title. The Aigles Bleus would go on to defeat the University of Guelph Gryphons in the final to win the University Cup and the Canadian Interuniversity Athletics Union (CIAU) championship in Toronto (Ontario).
